1. Corey Fields	Is in favor of acquiring open space, and hopes that Reimers Ranch gets on the ballot in November.
2. Karen Williamson	Is in support of a public skate park.
3. Seth Johnson	Is in favor of saving Reimers Ranch, and notes that there are no public skateboarding, rock climbing, bicycling, or mountain biking facilities in Austin, TX.
