New Electronic Voting System!

During our Early Voting period, Travis County voters will cast their ballots using new touch-button voting units. You don't have to be a computer nerd to operate these systems. In fact, they are easy to use even if you have never touched a computer before. There are also specially designed units that will make voting easier for people who are blind or have visual impairments. Just make your selection and push a button. Election officials will be happy to assist you if you have any questions or need a demonstration.

On Election Day, all precincts will also be voting using the touch-button voting units.

Voters who qualify to vote by mail will continue to use a paper ballot.

All You Need is an ID or Voter Registration Card!

Registered voters can vote with a voter registration card, any picture ID, preprinted in-state checks, a library card, two credit cards, or any official mail addressed and sent to you by a government agency.
